



01. Recognition for your volunteerism

There are three levels of recognition which you can participate in



Bronze status Criteria

Completion of 1 of 3 areas, or, 3 of 3 areas with each category to accomplish min 50% attained hrs.

- ❖ EVENT >= 60hrs
- ❖ SKILL >= 30hrs
- ❖ LEADERSHIP >= 30hrs

Silver status Criteria

Completion of at least 2 of 3 areas.

- ❖ EVENT >= 60hrs
- ❖ SKILL >= 30 hrs
- ❖ LEADERSHIP >=30 hrs

Gold status Criteria

To have completed all 3 areas

- ❖ EVENT >= 60hrs; AND
- ❖ SKILL >= 45hrs: AND
- ❖ LEADERSHIP >= 45hrs

02. How do I get started?

You don't have to be a superstar, you just have to be willing to show up and take an interest in bettering yourself!

Everyone starts by working toward their Bronze Level, which is designed to be achievable by any student. Once you've completed Bronze, you can move on to Silver if you like and, if you really love volunteering, you can tackle Gold! - but even earning one Level will help you make progress toward your goals.
