

## **Post-SICW 2025 Visit at Punggol Digital District: Strengthening International Cybersecurity Ties**

As a post-event engagement following Singapore International Cyber Week (SICW) 2025, the Association of Information Security Professionals (AiSP) was honoured to host an international delegation comprising representatives from the United Kingdom, Israel, and France on 24 October 2025.
