- 2. Welcome to the Cybersecurity Awards 2023.

- 4. I am pleased to welcome all of you here this evening to The Cybersecurity Awards and Gala Dinner 2023! The Cybersecurity Awards and Gala Dinner 2023 is held this evening leading to the start of the Singapore International Cyber Week 2023 that will be happening next week.
- 5. This year marks the 6th year of the Cybersecurity Awards and it has grown to be an important platform to recognise cybersecurity professionals and organisations for their contributions to the borderless cybersecurity ecosystem. This is especially so, with the acceleration of digitalization which makes a robust cybersecurity ecosystem even <u>more</u> <u>important</u> to ensure the resiliency of the nation, enterprises as well as individuals.

The awards is in the sixth year and this year we have over 60 professionals from AiSP and these supporting associations who have volunteered their personal time to contribute towards the organisation of this Awards. - 10. Overall, across all categories, it is heartening to see that we received a 50% increase in nominations in 2023 compared to 2022. After rounds of evaluation by the various judging panels, 17 finalists were identified. My heartiest congratulations to all finalists and award winners. No matter what the outcome is, every one of us seated down here is a winner in recognition.
- 11. We live in a highly digitalized environment and with AI and Chat GPT as a hot topic and helping us in our work and personal life. In the age of digitalization, cybersecurity attacks have become rampant. Cybercrimes is constantly on the rise which stresses on the importance for cybersecurity and good cyber hygiene practices.
- 12. Great to know that many companies and individuals are passionate in joint efforts to combat adversaries and making cyberspace safer for all. Through collaborative efforts, AiSP has done outreach to more than 25,000 people on the importance of Cyber-wellness and Online Cyber Safe Practices. This was done through Roadshows at shopping malls, Community Centres and schools through various initiatives such as Digital for Life. AiSP was awarded the People Association Community Spirit Merit Award earlier this year in July 2023 for the strong advocacy of work through continuous efforts and

contributions in promoting good cyber hygiene habits and digital wellness to the masses. This will not be possible without our EXCO, our members, our student volunteers and of course our secretariat.

At this point, I would like to use this opportunity to reflect upon my own journey volunteering as the President for AiSP as this is my last term in office. 4 years may seem long and during this time, I am glad to see how the cybersecurity ecosystem have grown more robust and resilient. Together, we have fostered a very cohesive cybersecurity community in Singapore and taken these beyond with regional and global groups.
