QISP is designed for entry to mid-level Information Security Professionals, and any IT Professionals who are keen to develop their knowledge in this field. - Undertake information security risk assessments of networks and systems and recommend risk treatment options.
- Craft appropriate information security policies to address information security risk.
- Manage operational security risks.
- Provide advice, from the information security perspective, on compliance with Singapore laws and regulations.
