MOH Advisory

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Qualified Information Security Professional (QISP) Course

The QISP course is jointly developed by AiSP and the Institute of Systems Science, National University of Singapore. QISP is designed for entry to mid-level Information Security Professionals, and any IT Professionals who are keen to develop their knowledge in this field.

As QISP will be revised to complement AiSP's newly updated Body of Knowledge 2.0, the last QISP exam based on the Body of Knowledge 1.0 would be held in May 2020. For more information on exam registration, course fees and funding, please visit to www.iss.nus.edu.sg.

BOK 2.0 Knowledge-Sharing and Networking Events

The Body of Knowledge (BOK) 2.0 caters to the professional development of information security (IS) personnel with relevant working experience between one to five years in Singapore.
