

# AiSP AI SIG Co-Lead Panelist Chat @ NTUC LearningHub AI Cyber Summit 2025 on 30 October

AiSP is delighted to share that our AI SIG Co-Lead, Cecil Su, was invited as a panelist for the fireside chat at the NTUC LearningHub AI Cyber Summit 2025 on 30 October. The session, "Responsible AI Meets Secure AI," brought together perspectives on how organisations can build trustworthy and resilient AI systems.

During the discussion, Cecil shared AiSP's perspective on how the convergence of AI ethics and cybersecurity is reshaping the skills required for Singapore's workforce, and the emerging competencies professionals must build to stay future-ready. The key message was clear: Responsible AI requires education, ethics, and enforcement — organisations must learn before they automate.

The fireside chat wrapped up the session with Q&A, addressing questions on AI security, ethical risks, and job transformation in the AI-driven future.




