Qualified Information Security Professional (QISP) Course

QISP course is jointly developed by AiSP and the Institute of Systems Science, National University of Singapore. It is designed for entry to mid-level Information Security Professionals, and any IT Professionals who are keen to develop their knowledge in this field. At the end of the course, you will be able to:

- Undertake information security risk assessments of networks and systems and recommend risk treatment options
- Craft appropriate information security policies to address information security risks
- Manage operations security risks
- Provide advice, from the information security perspective, on compliance with Singapore laws and regulations
