advance in the cyber workforce.





Close to 50 mentors – senior executives in the fields of cybersecurity technology, regulatory compliance, audit, product management and marketing – have signed up for the AiSP mentorship programme, and the association aims to double this number by end-2020.





Students under the programme will be able to hear about their mentors' work goals, skills, career progression strategies, education pathways and approaches to solving work related problems.

CYBERSECURITY STUDENTS AWARDED FOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO SINGAPORE'S CYBERSECURITY ECOSYSTEM



Students in cybersecurity disciplines recognised for their year-long contribution to Singapore's cybersecurity ecosystem. Five students received the Student Volunteer & Recognition Programme (SVRP) Gold Award for their contributions to Singapore's cybersecurity ecosystem, at the Association of Information Security Professionals' (AiSP) inaugural SVRP Award Ceremony on 6 Nov 19. The awards were presented by Guest of Honour Ms Sim Ann, Senior Minister of State for Communications and Information. There were also 33 Silver and 47 Bronze Award recipients.



Developed by AiSP and the Cyber Security Agency of Singapore (CSA), SVRP aims to encourage volunteerism amongst students while honing their interest and capabilities in cybersecurity. Since its inception on 1 Sep 2018, the programme has received strong



participation and support from local Institutes of Higher Learning (IHLs).

The students were assessed for qualities such as their passion and drive to contribute to the industry, and volunteering efforts throughout the year. The winners will be given internship opportunities with AiSP's partners: Acronis, Booz Allen Hamilton, Cyber Security Agency of Singapore, Ensign InfoSecurity, GOVTECH, Icyberwise, IHIS, PwC, Singtel (Trustwave) & TrendMicro.

The inaugural SVRP award ceremony which was held at the Lifelong Learning Institute also recognised Aaron Chan, the winner of the Student SVRP Logo Design Competition and also Bronze Award Recipient. PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Qualified Information Security Professional (QISP) Course

The QISP course is jointly developed by AiSP and the Institute of Systems Science, National University of Singapore. QISP is designed for entry to mid-level Information Security Professionals, and any IT Professionals who are keen to develop their knowledge in this field.

Body of Knowledge 2.0

AiSP, together with its volunteers, has completed the update of Body of Knowledge (BOK) 2.0 on 8 Nov 2019. The BOK 2.0 caters to the professional development of information security (IS) personnel with relevant working



experience between one to five years in Singapore. The domains in BOK 1.0 are currently covered in AiSP's Qualified Information Security Professionals (QISP) training. Details on implementation of BOK 2.0 for training would be shared in Q1 2020.

Its predecessor BOK 1.0 was completed in 2009, and the topics have increased from 12 (in BOK 1.0) to 22 as well. The ecosystem-centric initiative involves more than 40 volunteers across Singapore's IS professional spectrum contributed and reviewed concepts, terms and activities for the IS professional domain. As a "live" atlas, AiSP would continue to update its BOK consultation with its partners and industry players. AVIP Membership

AiSP launched its first validation programme based on peer review for information security (IS) professionals in Singapore on 7 Nov 2019. Named AiSP Validated Information Security Professionals (AVIP), the membership helps to validate credentials and experience for ISrelated work including cybersecurity, professional development and career progression for our professionals. The rigour in the validation is similar to professionals in other vocations such as accountants and engineers, and it is the first in Singapore base on peer review and not criterion based. Through AVIP, employers can better assess job applicants' credentials and work with their HR personnel to strengthen people development in IS domain. Also, industries can plan for their manpower, supporting functions and resources ahead to leverage opportunities arising from Singapore's digital transformation and cybersecurity development.

AVIP membership is the first in Asia to bundle the Professional Indemnity for professionals involved in cybersecurity related work, to give them greater assurance undertaking projects in Singapore and worldwide.
